EXPLORE ROTTNEEST ISLAND

ROTTNEEST ISLAND SITS JUST OFFSHORE FROM THE CITY OF PERTH, IN WESTERN AUSTRALIA. A PROTECTED NATURE RESERVE, IT'S FAMOUS FOR BEING THE HOME TO THE QUOKKA, A SMALL WALLABY-LIKE MARSUPIAL. WHITE-SAND BEACHES AND SECLUDED COVES INCLUDE THE BASIN, WITH ITS SHALLOW WATERS, AND THOMSON BAY, THE MAIN HUB AND FERRY PORT. STRICKLAND BAY IS KNOWN FOR ITS SURF BREAKS, WHILE REEF BREAKS OCCUR AT RADAR REEF, OFF THE ISLAND'S FAR WESTERN TIP.

ROTTNEEST EXPRESS

Rottneest Express offers an extensive range of both fully-escorted and self-guided day tour packages including complimentary morning transfers from hotels in Perth & Fremantle and a variety of on-island activities followed by an array of lunch options. Rottneest Island is home to some of the most spectacular white sandy beaches, secluded bays, unique wildlife including the famous quokka, shipwrecks and a fascinating and colourful history.

Rottneest Express' fleet of three high-speed, ocean going ferries have been specifically designed for the local sea conditions and are widely known for their smooth, fast and safe crossings.

WHEN TO VISIT

SEPTEMBER – APRIL

Most popular time to visit the island for swimming, snorkelling and other outdoor pursuits. Whales can often be spotted from September to mid-November.

MAY – AUGUST

Temperatures are still fairly mild in winter. Winter is drier and often a few degrees warmer than it is on the mainland.

FACTS & TIPS

- Rottneest island is 11 km long by 4.5 km wide and takes approximately 3-5 hours to ride around the island.
- During summer, bays on the south offer protection in the mornings from the prevailing easterly winds. By afternoon, the famous **Fremantle Doctor** (afternoon sea breeze) comes in from the south-west making the bays to the north such as The Basin, Parakeet Bay and Little Armstrong Bay the most enjoyable.



Rottneest is 11km in length and 4.5kms at its widest point. Suggested bike rides:

- Ride 1: 4km (0.5 hours)
- Ride 2: 10km (1.5 - 3 hours)
- Ride 3: 22km (3 - 5 hours)

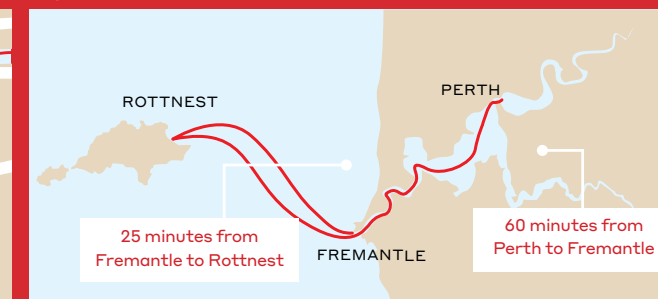

B SHED VICTORIA QUAY, FREMANTLE

Fremantle is the gateway to Rottnest Island.

An easy stroll from Fremantle train station, B Shed offers a convenient departure point and you'll get to see the hustle and bustle of a working port in action.

A fully licensed cafe, The Express Lane, is located at B Shed Ferry Terminal for your convenience whilst you wait for your departing ferry.

BARRACK STREET JETTY ELIZABETH QUAY, PERTH

The daily morning departures from Barrack Street Jetty provide an added benefit – a picturesque cruise along the majestic Swan River with commentary from our experienced hosts.

It offers the only direct service to the island.

Barrack Street Jetty is a tourist information hub and our friendly staff are trained to assist you make the most of your visit to Rottnest and Perth.

No parking is available at Barrack Street Jetty so we encourage passengers departing from here to take advantage of our complimentary metropolitan hotel pickup service or public transport (closest train station is The Esplanade Station or Blue Cat bus stop at Barrack Street Jetty).

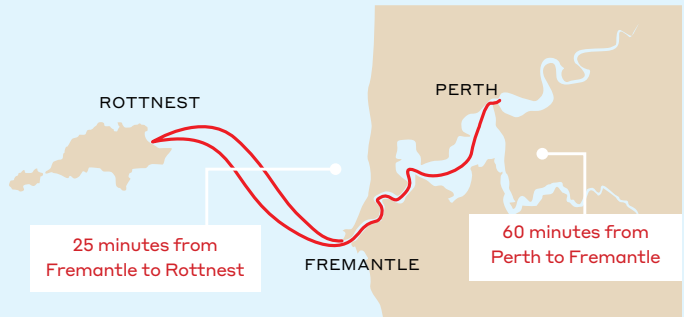
NORTHPORT ROUS HEAD HARBOUR, NORTH FREMANTLE

SEGWAY TOUR

Explore the best that Rottnest Island has to offer a little differently. Segway Tours WA will lead you on a journey of discovery and exploration into the islands most hidden treasures. All the while your senses will be engaged as you glide effortlessly around Rottnest, rich with history and diversity. With two varied tours to select from everyone can enjoy riding a Segway!

The 90-minute off-road Fortress Adventure tour will take you to the WWII gun emplacements and the stunning scenery of Bickley Bay through to Henrietta Rocks where there are various shipwrecks visible at low tide.

The 60-minute Settlement Explorer tour will take you through the original settlement and includes picturesque vistas of the coastal areas through to Bathurst Lighthouse and the Basin swimming area.

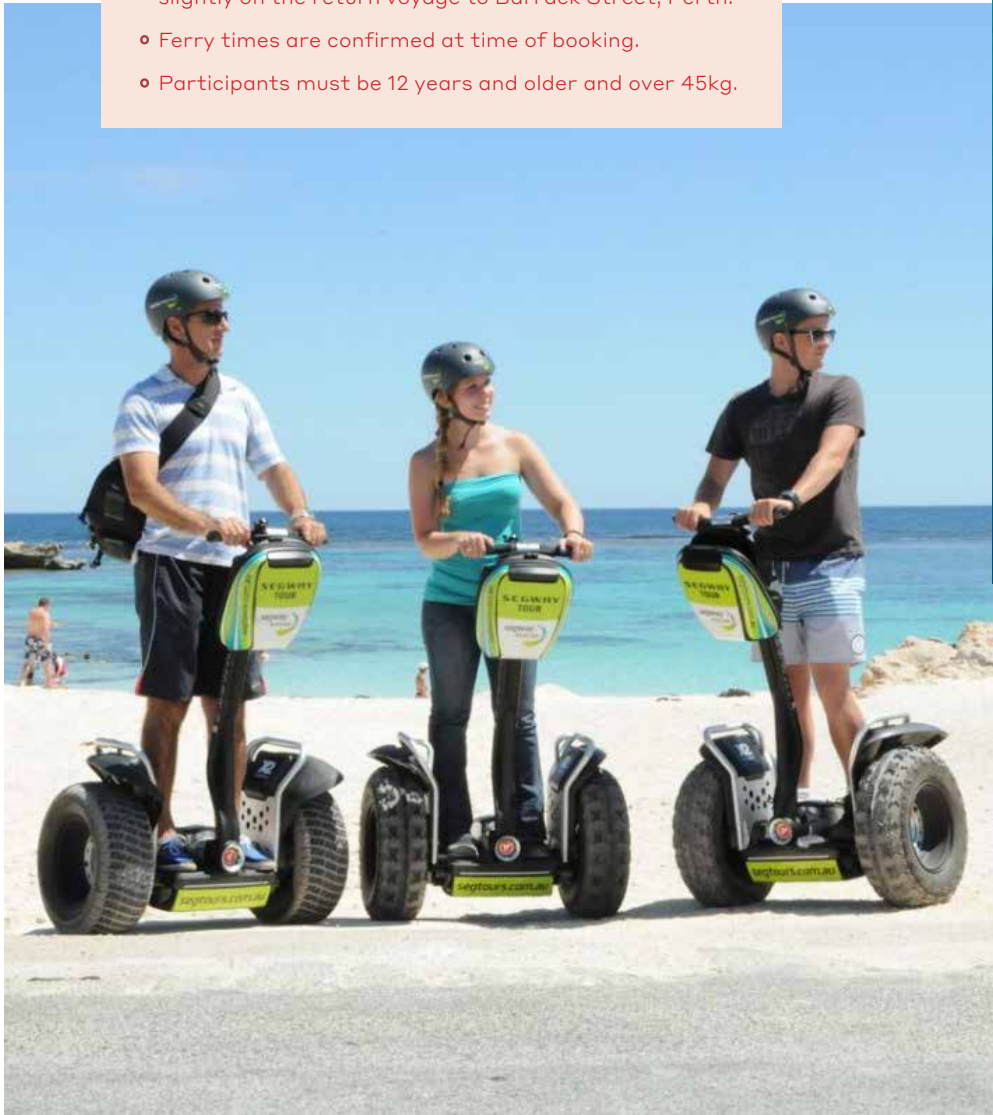

SKYDIVE GERONIMO

On your arrival at the Rottnest Island drop zone, you will meet your professional Geronimo team. Here they will harness you up and provide all safety information before your 20-minute scenic flight up to your chosen altitude, with amazing views of Perth city and WA coastline with the turquoise waters below you!

The adrenaline starts pumping as you leave the aircraft securely attached to your instructor and free-fall at 200km/h for up to 66 seconds! This is the ultimate rush...before passing through 5,000ft where your Tandem Skydiving Instructor will deploy your parachute. This is where the world starts to slow down and you have time to take it all in before safely landing on one of Rottnest Island's pristine beaches.

To celebrate your jump, enjoy a well-deserved complimentary drink at a local beachside restaurant and bar.

PAYMENT

For those agents who have credit terms approved, REX will invoice the company in respect of sums payable by Company under this agreement in the month following. Company shall settle such invoices within 14 days of presentation of an invoice. If the company has reasonable cause to dispute the amount stated in the invoice, then it shall be entitled to withhold payment of that invoice in full, until the dispute is settled. Prices quoted to the Company by REX are valid until the date agreed between the Company and REX and should be made in AUD\$. Agents who do not have credit terms approved, payment is required at the time of booking.

TOUR LEADER & ESCORT POLICY

Subject to minimum numbers, it is our policy to provide one Tour Escort* with complimentary travel on the ferry component of their journey, however where third party costs are involved related to Island Admission Fees, lunches or tours for escorts, these must be passed on.

Therefore, the following policy applies:

FIT/Group Bookings - less than 15 fee paying passengers: Escorts will be charged full contracted Nett rate.

FIT/Group Bookings – 15 or more fee paying passengers: 1 x free of charge travel will be provided when the group contains 15 or more fee paying passengers.

Subsequent Escorts charged at full contracted Nett rate

** For definition purposes 'Tour Escort' is defined as a Tour Leader, Tour Guide, Tour Coordinator or Escort.*

CANCELLATION POLICY

Due to the extensive organisations involved with touring, cancellation fees will be applicable to compensate for costs and lost revenue.

The following cancellation fees will apply:

0-24 hours (including no shows)
= 100% cancellation fee

24 hours – 1 week
= 25% cancellation fee

More than 1 week
= 0% cancellation fee

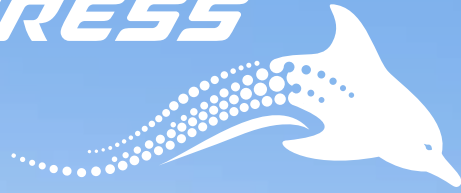
